Ampleon has long been committed to providing state of the art solutions for our customers and providing a reliable source of supply. In recognition that end applications often times require product support for an extended period of time, we have partnered with Flip Electronics so as to provide an ongoing source of supply of our LDMOS portfolio.

Flip Electronics has acquired the rights to support 206 part numbers from the LDMOS portfolio. This partnership allows us to concentrate on our newer product offerings and at the same time offer our customer base the opportunity to continue the use of the products they have designed in. This allows an avoidance of any costly redesign efforts and impact to the supply chain.

The original IP used in the original design, the exact wafer fabrication, the same assembly and test procedures are adhered to, so as to provide an end product that is identical to when originally procured from Ampleon. This is down to the original Ampleon part number and logo on the device. The only difference in the product is where it is procured from. The end result is no requalification of the product by our customer base.
